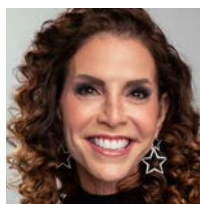

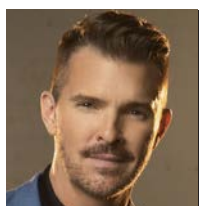
MARCIA MILGROM DODGE – *Director of Orphans*

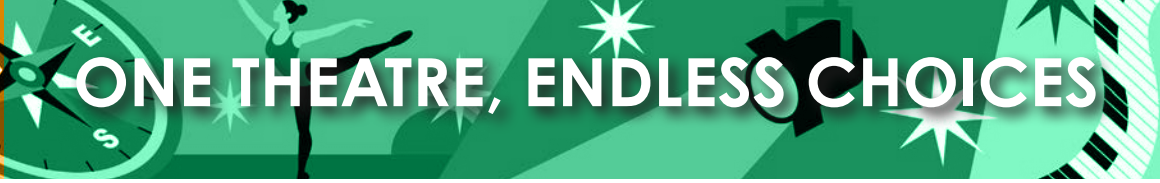

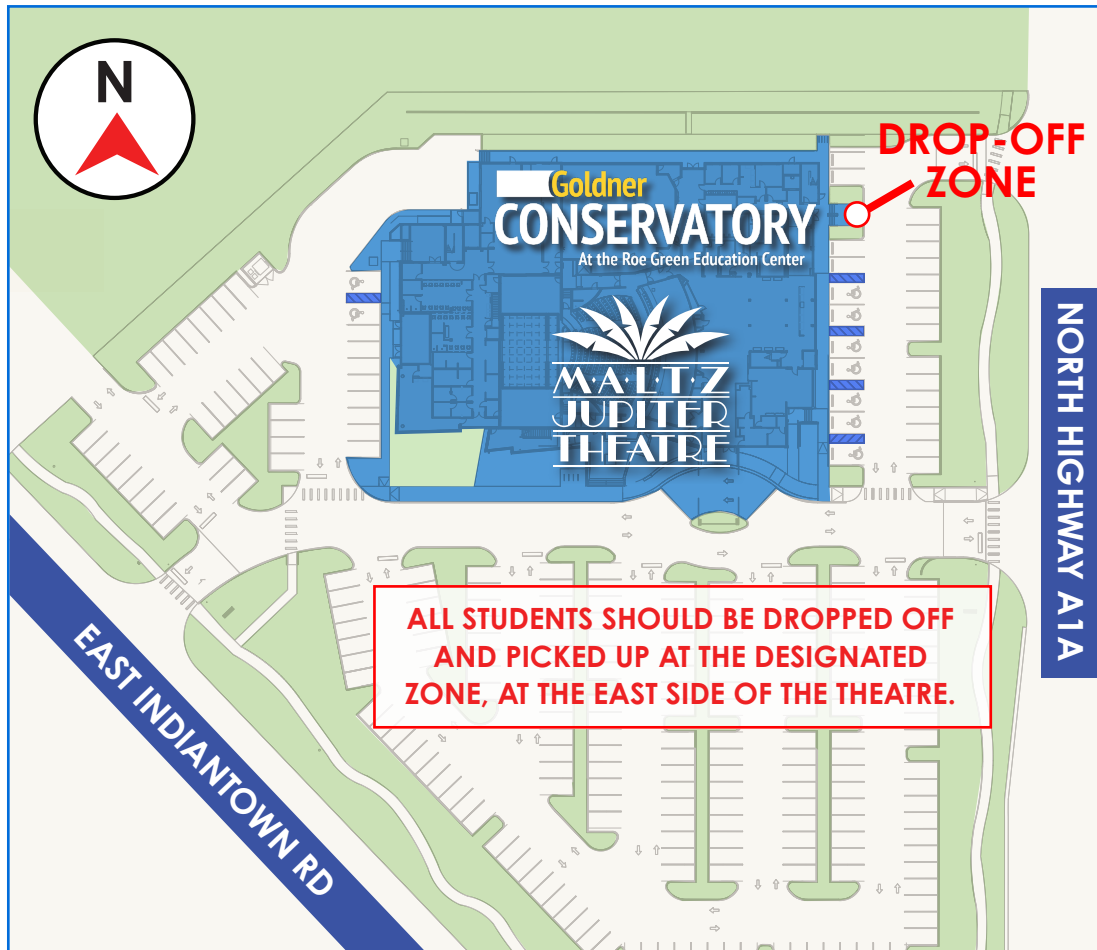
